## **Team Officials Code of Ethics**

4.1 Subject	Club policy on the conduct of BBFC team officials.
4.2 Purpose	To inform all team officials in regards to the conduct expected by the club.
4.3 Principle	At the Brindabella Blues Football Club we aim to improve conduct and management of team officials appointed by the club so as to supply a quality-sporting environment for all players and team officials.
4.4 Code of ethics	<ul> <li>All team officials are expected to observe the following codes:</li> <li>1. I will respect the rights, dignity and worth of all players and ensure that everyone is treated equally.</li> <li>2. I will ensure that the players are involved in a positive environment, and that the game and training is a positive and enjoyable experience.</li> <li>3. I will respect all player's individuality and help them reach their own full potential</li> <li>4. I will be fair, considerate and honest with all players.</li> <li>5. I will be fair, considerate and honest with all players.</li> <li>6. I will make a commitment to my team and myself that I will continue to improve my own knowledge of the game through coach education and various training programs.</li> <li>7. I will coach my players to play within the rules and in the spirit of the game of football.</li> <li>8. I will avoid any physical contact with the players and should it be required it would be appropriate to the situation and necessary for the player's skill development.</li> <li>9. I will refrain from any form of personal abuse towards my players and be aware of abuse directed towards players under my care.</li> <li>10. I will provide a safe environment for training and competition, by ensuring the equipment and facilities meet safety standards.</li> </ul>

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4.4 Code of ethics con't	<ol> <li>I will show concern and caution towards sick and injured players and allow for further participation in training and competition only when appropriate.</li> <li>I will not engage in the use of crude, foul or abusive language that may be determined offensive or engage in any conduct detrimental to the image of the game when on or off the field.</li> <li>I will refrain from arguing with the referee and/or assistant referees regarding decisions they make.</li> <li>I will treat participants, officials and spectators with courtesy and respect.</li> <li>I will always encourage my team to play within the laws of the game.</li> <li>I will not consent to the use of any banned substance, drugs of dependence or underage consumption of alcohol by my players.</li> </ol>
